It has been a long, cold winter...but we are still "blooming" with wonderful new initiatives that are exciting and impactful! This year, we are FOCUSing on who we are as a Section, and how we can be strong advocates for all Public Health Nurses in the state of Colorado. FOCUS is the initiative I launched in November and it is an acronym that stands for Foundations (fundamentals), Opportunities (optimizing), Commitment (collaboration), Unite (update), and Support (sustain).

As we FOCUS on our work, we have been diligently updating and modernizing the Colorado Public Health Nurse Competencies and started that work in January with our "focus" on Emergency Preparedness and Response. Public Health nursing went through tremendous trials, adversity, and challenges for the past three years as we strove to make our communities safe and healthy during the COVID pandemic. Nurses experienced both triumph and adversity as we were met with either praise or complaints trying to do our jobs. As we reflected on that work and the lessons learned from the experience - it became quite evident that the EPR Competencies that were developed a decade ago certainly needed to be revised. My sincere thanks is extended to the nurses who have worked tirelessly these past nearly three months to create a meaningful and impactful set of competencies that will help public health nurses become proficient and expert in their practice as it relates to Emergency Preparedness and Response. Exciting lists of resources, suggested readings, and training are included in the document. I anticipate that the final version of the EPR competencies will be ready for use in mid-Spring.


